Course Description:

Students continue their study of art by applying their knowledge of media, tools, techniques and art elements and principles to original artwork. Many art forms are studied, including a variety of drawing media, painting media and mixed media. Students study art from other cultures, regions, and time periods, to develop an understanding of how historical and contemporary artwork is used to inspire original artwork.

Students will have the opportunity to demonstrate their knowledge and understanding of each medium through multiple measures of assessment. Grades will be based on unit projects, classwork exercises, artist statements, critiques and visual journal assignments.

Each assignment will have a due-date. This is the date by which you are expected to submit the assignment. 10% of the final project grade will be deducted if work is turned in late. The deadline is the last day an assignment will be accepted for a grade. Work not turned in by the deadline will be recorded in the gradebook as zero (0). Work turned in before the deadline can be reassessed.
