#### **Course Description:**

Students continue building a portfolio of artwork and an art journal. Personal style emerges through a selection of media, subject matter and art forms used to solve visual problems. Visual journal assignments, group critiques, and visuals are used to help students develop an aesthetic vocabulary and an appreciation for art as an expression of human experience. This course will be used to prepare students for AP Studio Art 2-D Design Course/Exam.

Each quarter will focus on painting media, surface techniques, and painting styles. Students will have the opportunity to demonstrate their knowledge and understanding of each medium through multiple measures of assessment. Grades will be based on unit projects, classwork exercises, artist statements, critiques and visual journal assignments.

Each assignment will have a due-date. This is the date by which you are expected to submit the assignment. 10% of the final project grade will be deducted if work is turned in late. The deadline is the last day an assignment will be accepted for a grade. Work not turned in by the deadline will be recorded in the gradebook as zero (0). Work turned in before the deadline can be reassessed.
